



AN ACT

To require compliant flame mitigation devices to be used on portable fuel containers for flammable liquid fuels, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the ``Portable Fuel Container Safety Act of 2019''.

SEC. 2. PERFORMANCE STANDARDS TO PROTECT AGAINST PORTABLE FUEL CONTAINER EXPLOSIONS NEAR OPEN FLAMES OR OTHER IGNITION SOURCES.

(a) Rule on Safety Performance Standards Required.--Not later than 30 months after the date of enactment of this section, the Consumer Product Safety Commission (referred to in this Act as the ``Commission'') shall promulgate a final rule to require flame mitigation devices in portable fuel containers that impede the propagation of flame into the container, except as provided in
