## Digital FDLP discussion – Brent Abercrombie

- Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP) will transition to digital; greatly reduce number of tangible items distributed to Federal Depository Libraries (FDLs)
- What is Indiana's presence going to be in FDLP and in Midwest National Collection Service Area?
- Start brainstorming collaborative collection development and resource-sharing efforts
- What libraries are really good at interlibrary loan (ILL) for government documents in Midwest Service Area?
  - Indiana State Library (ISL) tries not to ILL material out of state
  - Big 10 Academic Alliance will ILL to other Big 10 universities
- Please attend meetings of Midwest National Collection Service area
  - Need to reach all depository coordinators, not just INDIGO members
  - People need to update their information in the FDLP directory
  - Complete biennial survey
  - Teams channel? Brent will look into setting up **consensus** reached
  - Could we provide incentives for people to participate?
  - We anticipate having fewer FDLs in near future
- Digital-first FDLP is more of a service model
  - We have requested talking points from Scot Matheson to give to library directors about why to remain in FDLP
  - o GPO is mindful of fact that space and time are limited in libraries
- Need to figure out who wants to continue receiving print material in the state; begin forging relationships with other libraries in our region
- Identify what level of commitment your institution wants to retain in the program
- What Indiana FDLs are also preservation stewards?
  - Can we put onus on updating preservation steward map/list on GPO?
  - Jennifer can work with Brent to take this forward to GPO as request from INDIGO
  - Andrea made motion for this, seconded by Bert **consensus** reached
  - Could a grad student (under Emily) draft a model map? Assuming initial buy-in from GPO
- Light Archive?
- Floppy disc project? Includes CD-ROMs
- GPO took over Documents Data Miner could they also take over floppy disc project? Lou Malcomb will get the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to Emily Alford
- Could Brent have a conference call with participants right before or after Midwest NCSA meetings? Over Teams channel he will set up
